**Valedictorian:** The valedictorian for the Grad Class of 2024 will be selected by a panel consisting of administration, teaching staff and student representatives. Candidates interested in representing their classmates must fulfill the following criteria to put their name forward:

1. have a cumulative academic average of at least 85% during the first three reporting periods of grade twelve,
2. be approved by the office,
3. present to the panel on a selected topic to see how well you speak publicly, and
4. must agree to work with a teacher supervisor in preparation for presentation and recording of the valedictorian address at the Grad Assembly.

Valedictorian applications will be available through MS Forms on Wednesday May 1, 2024 and should be submitted by Wednesday May 15, 2024. MS Form information will be posted and shared with potential graduates. Successful candidates will be notified of further details with regards to the selection process by Ms. MacConnell.

**Graduation Ceremonies:** Similar to previous years, we will continue with a walk-through ceremony event and encourage families to invite their guests to join you during the specified times. There is no limit on the number of guests each family may bring to the ceremony. Each graduate and their family will be greeted upon arrival and will proceed through the processional to the theatre. Guests with mobility issues will have support getting to the theatre. Gown packages (cap, gown, v-stole) will be available at a special pick-up day to be announced to all parents and graduates.

**Graduation Honour Cords:** Students who graduate with honours will receive special recognition at the Graduation Ceremony and be given an Honour Cord to wear with their graduation gown. This will be presented to the graduate upon arrival to their ceremony. To obtain graduation honours, students must have an 80% average in both their grade 11 and grade 12 years.
